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


Why exemption management matters

Sales tax overview

There are 45 states plus the District of Columbia that impose a state sales and use tax. In addition, some local jurisdictions either separately administer their sales tax or maintain a different tax base than the state (i.e., locals in Alabama, Arizona, Colorado and Louisiana).

The states of New Hampshire, Oregon, Montana, Alaska, and Delaware do not impose a state level sales and use tax. Puerto Rico also imposes a sales and use tax.

2.9% – 7.25% Most state sales tax rate 0.07% - 5.22% Local taxes, which are often imposed in addition to the state sales



Nexus

Nexus describes the contacts you have with a given state and establishes whether that state can obligate your company to collect sales taxes.



Physical presence (old rules)

- Employees in a state –register for payroll taxes
- Locations in a state paying property taxes
- Sending employees into a state deliveries, repairs, conferences
- > And more...



Economic nexus (new rules)

- > Click-through
- > Affiliate
- > Sales volumes exceed thresholds
- Marketplace

Economic nexus

WHAT IS IT?

Economic nexus is a tax collection obligation imposed on sellers based on their level of economic activity within a state.

Unlike physical presence, it is based entirely on sales revenue, transaction volume, or

both.

Sales tax compliance is now like income tax, all businesses must address where and when they have an obligation



Nexus – After Wayfair

Sales & tax evaluations

Volume of sales by state



Most states using total sales, not just taxable



Most states are using around \$100,000 in sales

Number of transactions by state



Most states are using 200 transactions

Note: every state is different and each needs to be evaluated independently









Audits

Questions to consider

- > Who is going to be pulling the exemption certificates for the auditor? Do you have the staff and the resources?
- Do you know what you are lacking? Who is going to reach out to your customers to get missing, invalid certificates, or XYZ letters?
- Have you made improvements since your last audit? Have things gotten worse?
- Are you going to rebill your customers the tax?
 Do you know which customers you need to rebill?



Audit preparation is crucial





- Scrambling to gather documentation at the last minute
- Customers have gone out of business, can't collect tax retroactively

- > Projected audit results: One missing certificate could result in large assessment
- Eat the tax: Tax that your customer should have paid is now yours to pay
- Rebill the customer: Requesting tax after the fact can negatively impact customer relations

More important than audits

Customer service problems



Charging tax when you shouldn't

Have customers given you the proper documenttation and is there a disconnect to billing?



Not charging tax when you should

Ultimately, this will probably hit you under audit



Impact on Accounts Receivable (AR)

Customers shortpaying tax leads to headaches in AR department
